

This project is implemented by a consortium led by the Infectious Diseases Research Collaboration (IDRC) in collaboration with, the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine (LSHTM), the Uganda Heart Institute (UHI), the Ministry of Health Uganda (MoH) and Makerere University.
